WHAT IS THE IAC 2024 ABOUT?

The International Astronautical Congress (IAC) returns to Italy for its 75th edition, with previous successful editions held in Rome, Turin, and Naples. This landmark event is set to take place in the captivating city of Milan from October 14th to 18th, 2024, specifically at Allianz MiCo, Europe's largest convention center.

Exceptionally this year, the IAC is hosted by the Italian Association of Aeronautics and Astronautics (AIDAA), founder member of IAF, and co-hosted by the Italian Space Agency (ASI) and Leonardo, representing together the entire ecosystem of space activities in Italy.

This edition of the IAC holds special significance as it commemorates the 60th anniversary of Italy's inaugural satellite, San Marco 1, launched on December 15th, 1964, by an Italian crew using an American Scout rocket from Virginia's Wallops Flight Facility. Reflecting on this historic milestone, and under the motto "Responsible Space for Sustainability," the IAC 2024 aims to cultivate a collective commitment to responsible space exploration and utilization, ensuring a sustainable future for Earth and beyond.

The event will bring together students, researchers, industry leaders, young professionals, and national representatives to share recent discoveries, discuss new technologies, and foster international collaborations. The congress provides a platform to connect with like-minded individuals, exchange insights, and explore the limitless possibilities that space offers for the benefit of humanity.

THE ACTORS BEHIND THE IAC

The IAC is a joint effort between the International Astronautical Federation (IAF) and a local Host.

The IAF organizes and coordinates the overall programme of the Congress. Some elements of the IAC programme are prepared with the support of the IAF Partners – the International Academy of Astronautics (IAA), the International Institute of Space Law (IISL) and the Space Generation Advisory Council (SGAC) who contribute to the IAC through their particular events and symposia.

The Host, coordinates the logistical elements of the Congress, ensuring that local space actors and developments, and the local culture and customs become an integral part of the event.

AIDAA promotes its activity through the organization of conferences, workshops, roundtables, competitions with prizes for studies and research, publication proceedings, and through the international journal "Aerotecnica Missili e Spazio – Journal of Aerospace Science, Technologies, and Systems".

The association is managed by an Governing Board which includes members of the Italian Universities (Milan, Turin, Padua, Bologna, Pisa, Rome, Naples, Palermo, Enna, Genoa), ASI, Leonardo and the Italian Aerospace Research Center (CIRA).
