Why it matters:

- OQ Technology operates the **world's first 3GPP-compliant satellite 5G IoT constellation** with 10 satellites in orbit.
- The company is expanding into Australia to provide **mission-critical connectivity** for agriculture, mining, energy, logistics, maritime, and emergency services.
- Backed by the **5NETSAT mission** and a **€2.5M European Innovation Council grant**, OQ is pioneering **direct-to-mobile satellite services** capable of delivering **emergency SMS and broadcast alerts** to unmodified smartphones.
- The launch aligns with Australia's **LEOSat Working Group priorities**, including digital inclusion, First Nations connectivity, and emergency communications resilience.
