

## The Global Conference on Space for Emerging Countries – GLEC 2019 Financial Models and Resourcing

The upcoming Global Conference on Space for Emerging Countries - GLEC 2019 to be held from 24 - 26 April 2019 in Marrakech, Morocco will feature on Wednesday 24 a session on the Financial Models and Resourcing.

Given the many competing social and economic priorities of emerging countries, the finances usually committed to national space programs is generally sub-optimal. However, additional levels of funding are contingent upon demonstrating an appreciable value proposition through either a return on investment or value on investment. The Session focus will be on:

- 1. Categorising the financial models that could be adopted in national/regional space programs, and
- 2. Pinpointing what development banks are looking for in providing financial loans and assistance for space technologies and applications.

The first part of the session will feature a Keynote Address from 16:00 - 16:15 from **Steve Bochinger**, COO at EUROCONSULT followed by Plenary 2 moderated by **Joerg Kreisel**, CEO of JKIC and welcoming as speakers **Talal Al Kaissi**, Advisor – Strategic Projects, UAE Space Agency, **Feng ZHOU**, Vice President, DFH-China Academy of Space Technology (CAST), **Carlos Alvarado**, President, Central American Association for Aeronautics and Space (ACAE), and **Mmboneni Muofhe**, Co-chair, Group on Earth Observation.
