Authors will hear of the outcome within the next three weeks.

This surge in entries (+30% compared to the GLEX 2020 abstract submission rate) is evidence of the considerable interest going on due to recent developments and outstanding achievements in space. GLEX 2021 is a remarkable occasion where the global space community is invited to meet and re-connect on the 60th anniversary of Yuri Gagarin's Space Flight to reflect on the trends, challenges and opportunities in space exploration.
