






#INVOLVING EVERYONE





he 69th International Astronautical Congress was an impressive IAC that broke many records! It truly lived up to its motto #InvolvingEveryone by bringing together the record number of 6,548 delegates from 81 countries in Bremen. This year a special programme had been created for the public day, which saw more than 10,000 participants that witnessed the exceptional live session with Alexander Gerst from the International Space Station (ISS).

IAC 2018 proved to be the most intense yet, with a full-packed schedule for the whole five days. The Plenary Programme saw many interesting panels, including a Highlight Lecture on business opportunities in space by Tom Enders from Airbus and a Late Breaking News session on the space missions HAYABUSA2, MASCOT, MINERVA II. The Technical Programme received a record number of abstract submissions and authors from all over the world came to present their research in 179 Technical Sessions and in the Interactive Presentation Session. As part of the Technical Programme, the new format Special Sessions (SpS) was introduced for the first time. The IAF Global Networking Forum has grown in recent years and offered a record of 46 GNF Sessions on a variety of topics.

In the IAF General Assembly, several important decisions were taken. Pascale Ehrenfreund, Chair of the DLR Executive Board, was elected as the new Incoming IAF President, and will be the first female president of the Federation. Her presidency will begin in October 2019. Additionally Paris, France was selected as Host City for IAC 2021. The Hosting Organization is the Centre National d'Études Spatiales (CNES), a member of IAF since 1981.

I hope you will enjoy this booklet capturing all the main highlights of IAC 2018 in Bremen. The next IAC will be held in Washington D.C. 21-25 October 2019. I look forward to welcoming you @ll at IAC 2019!
