**Ankara, Türkiye** - Mehmet Fatih Kacır, Minister of Industry and Technology, met with the International Astronautical Federation (IAF) delegation and representatives of the IAC 2026 Local Organising Committee to review the progress of preparations for the **77<sup>th</sup> International Astronautical Congress (IAC 2026)**, to be held **5-9 October 2026** in **Antalya, Türkiye**.

Widely recognized as the world's largest and most prestigious gathering of the global space community, the International Astronautical Congress (IAC) brings together space agencies, industry leaders, researchers, and innovators shaping the future of the sector.
